





Source of Referral (March'19-Feb'20)







SHIFT IN APPROACH DURING COVID – INTENSIVE WORK WITH ASHAs










Responding to Primary Needs

172 Villages in 6 Blocks from 3 Districts in Gujarat – 22 health facilities

- Food kits with dry ration to vulnerable households – 1963 households
- Medicine kits for COVID + patients through PHCs and CHCs – 1050 Wellness kits 700 patients
- Equipping the frontline health workers with hygiene and safety kits (oximeters, N95 masks, sanitizers) – more than 300 ASHAs and AWWs
- Direct Cash Support to families of COVID deceased earning member – 33 households



Ensuring that small and marginal farmers are not pushed into debt or distress sale of assets through providing improved agricultural inputs



Ensuring food security by supporting production of food crops



Create a seed bank for future years and promoting sustainable, low chemical agriculture

Demonstrations and capacity building support for making farmyard manure and fertilizers and sustainable farming methods were provided to all the women farmers along with seeds of improved variety, natural bio growth promoters, Neem oil and organic manure –

25 villages from two blocks – Dasada and Dhranghdra from Surendranagar district

Study to understand the gendered impact of COVID-19 pandemic and the lock-down with an aim to document the challenges faced by women and girls in rural areas of Surendranagar, Gujarat. The area of enquiry included impact on income security, essential public services, coping mechanisms and violence.

RCRC Coalition Household Surveys – three rounds - to monitor the impact of COVID-19 outbreak at the household level which captured the essential aspects of the impact such as availability of food, cash and employment, planning for agriculture and livestock activities, status of well-being, education, health and entitlements


Research Initiatives

Undertook a Gendered Impact of COVID 19 study with 5 other organizations as part of the RCRC coalition. Study probes into areas of women's health, education, impact on women of COVID affected family members, covid affected women's experiences, education, covid treatment and covid vaccines.

Dipstick study on the number of deaths in the rural areas – to verify the numbers of unreported Covid deaths which helps in strategizing the provision of support to communities and health workers in rural areas, seek public policy intervention, and provide relief and assistance to the most vulnerable.



થર્મોમીટરનો ઉપયોગ કરતા પહેલા આટલું કરો -

- સૌ પ્રથમ આપના હાથ સાબુ અને પાણીથી ધુઓ.
- થર્મોમીટરને સાફ કરવા માટે એને સાદા પાણીથી ઘોઈ નાખો. ત્યારબાદ, ૩ પર સેનીટાઈઝર લઈ થર્મોમીટર પર લગાડી તેને વ્યવસ્થિત સાફ કરો લ્યો. (ધાતુ ની જગ્યાવાળા ભાગ ને વધારે સારી રીતે સાફ કરવું) છેલ્લે તેને ઠંડા પાણીથી ધો લ્યો. અને સાદા કાપડથી એને સાફ કરી લ્યો.




